Some main conclusions of the partnership in this TPM:

- The RecyclART method works with all different types of unemployed people through the workshops
- Someone who initially belongs to the unemployed people can migrate to the second group of artists after experiencing the RecyclART method, by studying the handbook and practicing the exercises.
- The partnership managed to produce even more than expected as the handbook and many materials include Vocal Orientation Exercises and A useful guide for someone who organizes a RecyclART workshop.
- Decisions on next phase and the platform as well as partners responsibilities for the success of our platform on recycling opportunities, will support all the action.













The team has been working on the project for almost 2 years and meeting face to face brings great joy! We worked around project activities such as our multiplier event that will take place in March. The main topic of the meeting though was the RecyclART platform which will be a free open space aimed for adults (especially long term unemployed), recycling artists, artists in general, adult educators, people interested in creative



- And if you want to share your own projects or you'd like to offer materials to others, then make sure to <u>register</u> and then check-out our <u>platform guide.</u>


